The new Fort Collins Rescue Mission is a unique public private partnership years in the making. We have received public funds from the State of Colorado, Larimer County, and City of Fort Collins through American Rescue Plan Act allocations. We are also grateful for the major support already in place from the Bohemian Foundation and the dedication of funds from the Denver Rescue Mission. These entities have committed approximately 75% of the cost of this project. Now we turn to donors like you to help us secure the remaining 25% of the funds necessary to make this new facility a reality.
